BRINSEA BATCH, CONGRESBURY, NORTH SOMERSET (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY VEHICLES) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to install a water main. This will become operative on the **17 July 2017** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **fifteen days** in duration.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

Brinsea Batch (part unaffected), King Road, Church Lane, Front Street, Dinghurst Road (A368), Bristol Road (A38), Stock Lane (B3133), Brinsea Batch (part unaffected) and vice versa.
