

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on 11th March 2024

There were 5 members of the public present.

Public Questions-questions were raised regarding the flooding at Church Lane and the Bishops Well, the roundabout proposal at Churchill lights and the amended planning application at Hilliers Lane.

24/FC3A To receive any apologies for non-attendance.

Councillors J Murray and B Wilkinson sent their apologies.

24/FC3B To receive any declarations of interest on agenda items.

There were no declarations of interest.

24/FC3C To confirm and sign the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 12th February

24/FC3D North Somerset Matters

Councillor Keating advised that bus scheme improvement plan consultation is available online for residents to respond and a drop in face-to-face event planned for 2.4.24 at the Memorial Hall, Churchill from 4-7pm.

Alun Griffiths have pulled out of the Banwell Bypass and North Somerset Council as addressing the legal consequences and looking for a replacement contractor. In the interim North Somerset Council are considering what can be implemented by Highways regarding Churchill mitigations. Wainwrights will be carrying out work on potholes in the county.

24/FC3E To consider the floor at the Community Club.

This item was postponed until further notice.

24/FC3F To consider the quote to replace the sleepers at the hand and memorial garden.

24/FC3G

To consider the quote to add a soakaway at the bottom part of the recreation field to prevent flooding to the community club and car park.

The Parish Council agreed to an interim solution to reduce the height of the slabs at the rear of the Community club by 4 inches and to make the ditch deeper along the hedge of Turnpike field to allow water to drain away from the rear wall of the Community Club. The soakaway and drainage solution at the bottom of the recreation field will be discussed and quotes obtained.

24/FC3H

To consider North Somerset Council's Bus Improvement Scheme proposal for a roundabout at Churchill lights.

The Parish Council discussed the proposal and agree this is an unnecessary solution to a problem that does not exist and delays are rare due to the traffic lights. Delays only occur if there are issues with the M5 motorway.

There is inadequate space on the A38 for a bus lane which will impact those residents who live on the A38 and will remove parish green spaces with trees and flowers.

The flooding on the A38 and A368 is a huge concern and occurs regularly. This will need to be addressed and work undertaken to ensure that the consequent flooding of other roads like Ladymead Lane is improved not worsened.

The proposal to move the bus stop needs to be detailed as there is no location listed and the roads are narrow to accommodate a new bus stop.

Access to the Ambulance Station will need to be considered.

Access from Ladymead Lane is currently assisted by the traffic lights – however this would be difficult to exit on to A38 as there would be a constant flow of vehicles

22/P/1172/FUL	Land off Hilliers Lane, Churchill	Erection of 34 dwellings, public open space, landscaping, sustainable urban drainage system and engineering works, with vehicular access off Hillier's Lane Churchill Parish Council object to the newly added proposals, full response available on North Somerset Council planning portal.
24/P/0272/FUH	Lenville, Bristol Road, Churchill	Retrospective application for the increase of front boundary wall height and rendering of the new wall. Proposed installation of electronic gates and convex mirrors. Churchill Parish Council object to this application as the height of the gate is too high, the materials are not in keeping with the area and congestion could occur entering the property. The planning process is in place to consider applications before they are carried out. Retrospective applications sets a precedent for this process not to be followed.

24/FC3L To receive matters for information

Councillor Ronicle contacted Highways at North Somerset Council regarding flooding in Langford and Blackmoor. The gulleys and culverts need to be cleaned and he has asked for this to be scheduled for spring 2024. The lighting issues at the main house at the university have been resolved. A meeting is scheduled to discuss the lighting concerns at Wyndham Farm track. The speed indicator device has been lent to Burrington Parish Council and will return to Langford this month. Councillor Bush advised that there are several substantial pot holes/tarmac has lifted on Ladymead Lane which the clerk will report.
